## Required before practical work

You must complete the online theory modules before you can attempt the practical session.

### Your pathway

- 1 Enrol and log in**  
Use the eLearn portal to access modules, documents and resources.
- 2 Complete theory**  
Finish the required online modules before your practical date.
- 3 Attend practical**  
Join the two-day in-person practical training and assessment when ready.

### Theory modules to finish

- Human factors and TEM
- Aircraft Radio Operator Certificate

### Bring to practical

- Weather-appropriate clothing, enclosed comfortable shoes, sunglasses, sunscreen and a water bottle.
- A notepad, laptop, tablet or iPad for face-to-face learning activities.
- An iOS or Android device and your phone charge cable so you can connect to the remote controller.
- DJI GO 4 installed before the practical session if instructed by your course team.
